About the Blue Pulse Safety Climate Survey

The Blue Pulse Safety Climate Survey consists of three main sections:

- · Section A: Job Demographics.
- · Section B: Health and Safety Questions.
- · Section C: Open-Ended Questions.

Section A gathers demographic information from participants. This can include relevant details such as length of tenure, department, and job level.

Section B consists of items where responses are rated along a 5-point scale that ranges from strongly agree to strongly disagree. These items are grouped into the following safety climate factors:

- 1. Management Commitment.
- 2. Team Functioning.
- 3. Morale.
- 4. Supervisor Commitment.
- 5. Safety Accountability.
- 6. Risk-Taking Behaviour.
- 7. Safety Procedures and Systems.

Section C consists of two open-ended questions that provide participants with the opportunity to express their thoughts and further opinions on safety.

The Blue Pulse Safety Climate Survey also allows in-depth information to be obtained via our structured interviews. These can be completed either over the phone or face-to-face.

The Blue Pulse Safety Climate Survey consists of a standard set of questions with the option to customise questions to meet the needs of the organisation.

The Blue Pulse Safety Climate Survey Process

Administration & Data Collection

PSB Solutions can provide you with either a paper or online survey (or a a combination of both, depending on your needs) for distribution to participants.

The Blue Pulse Safety Climate Survey can also be administrated via a structured interview process by one of our consultants. These structured interviews can be conducted either face-to-face or over the phone. This is recommended as the structured interview will provide insight into why people have responded in a particular way.

Analysis of Results

The analysis focuses on reviewing and detailing the mean (average) and standard deviation (variation from the average), and provides a percentage breakdown between favourable, neutral and unfavourable responses for each survey item. A theme analysis is conducted on the open-ended questions to identify safety themes that are raised by participants. A theme analysis helps to identify areas of strength as well as areas of improvement at a glance. The survey can be conducted yearly and benchmarked against previous surveys to identify meaningful changes in employee responses.

Comprehensive Report

A comprehensive report will be provided presenting both numerical and graphical information, recommendations for improvement and benchmarking data (if available from a previous survey run).
